NT Govt failed to ensure safety: coroner

DARWIN: The Northern Territory coroner found yesterday that the NT Government had failed to ensure public safety in last May's Cannonball Run, but that driver

error had actually led to four deaths in the event.

A Ferrari crashed into a checkpoint about 100km south of Alice Springs, killing its two Japanese

occupants and two race officials.

Coroner John Lowndes said the Government should not have delegated responsibility for public safety to race organisers.
